

### Rationale for Collective Worship




It is a time when the school community can express itself and develop spiritually both as a group and individually. Each half term we use our gateways to guide us through a set of underpinning Christian values. We use the Roots and Fruits Christian values (**green**) and our Gateway values (**purple**) to ensure our values led approach to worship is intertwined and linked to our curriculum. All worships will have a theological approach, explaining how the gospels reveal the way in which Jesus embodied these values.
