

Maths - Home Learning Year 6

Please continue to work through the Maths questions in your packs.

Don't be worried about the amount of questions, as you will only do a few each day. Try to follow my instructions, but don't get stressed about it - just do your best.

I have included the pupil friendly answers for all test papers, as it is important (as always) to highlight the questions that you got wrong and to spend some time to try to work out why (see SATs Ninjas sheet for help with this).

I obviously trust you not to look at the answers before you have attempted the questions.



A typical lesson could look like this:

Work on 9 arithmetic questions

Work on 10 reasoning questions

You should find that by the fourth day you have completed Set A (both the arithmetic and the reasoning papers). On the fifth day mark your answers using the mark scheme and work on your corrections. Follow your SATs Ninja sheets for help with this.
